Mathematics

The children will be:

- Using numbers to 10 and beyond, comparing groups of objects.
- Following and using positional language to find objects.
- Beginning to order a variety of objects by size, length, height or weight.
- Exploring & using variety of 2D & 3D shapes.

Understanding the World

The children will be:

- Exploring indoor & environments including a visit to the park and talking about some of the things they have observed.
- Using ICT to interact with age appropriate outdoor software.
- Exploring different occupations including fire fighters, police & medical staff.

Literacy/Communication & Language

The children will be:

- Listening to & retelling stories about people who help us, transport, clothes we wear in autumn & Christmas.
- Talking & listening to each other in small group activities, sharing our news.
- Sharing books in small adult led groups.

Phonics

The children will be:

- Continuing to learn letter sounds using the Read Write Inc. phonics programme.
- Beginning to blend sounds together to read words and sentences.
- Beginning to write their name & other simple words using phonic knowledge.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be:

- Talking & listening to each other in small groups, sharing news & their interests.
- Exploring resources related to people who help us & transport.
- Developing good relationships, taking turns & sharing resources.

The children will be:

- Continuing to look at the topic 'Welcome' talking about Baptism.
- Discussing what a birthday is, learning about Advent, looking forward to Christmas and the birthday of Jesus.
- Taking part in Nativity activities, leading to an EYFS & KS1 performance.

Physical Development

The children will be:

- Taking part in P.E sessions with a Sports Coach, to develop skills using equipment & moving in a variety of ways.
- Continuing to develop fine motor skills, using scissors, tools & pencils.
- Negotiating outdoor space successfully when playing games.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will be:

- **Developing role-play activities in the home area.**
- **Joining in with weekly drumming**
- **Sessions & exploring the sounds of different instruments.**
- **Using a variety of materials & colours to create autumn & Christmas artwork.**
- **Exploring variety of emergency & other vehicles in small world area.**
