Spring Term Two

Mathematics

The children will be:

- Beginning to represent numbers using fingers, written marks or pictures.
- Counting irregular arrangements of objects & matching to the correct numeral to 10, and then beyond.
- Measuring their height in our role play Medical Centre.
- Starting to use everyday language to talk about height, weight & capacity.

Literacy/Communication & Language

The children will be:

- Listening to & retelling stories including, I'd Rather go to Grandad's, & using non-fiction books about people who help us and types of transport.
- Extending their vocabulary and using language to imagine and recreate stories in our Medical Centre role play.
- Taking part in story activities with parents and carers.

Understanding the World

The children will be:

- Developing an understanding of growth and change in the outdoor area and by helping to care for our eggs and chicks.
- Interact with age appropriate software, using I pads & operating robots.
- Finding out about different occupations through visits from Community Police Officers and an Author.

Phonics

The children will continue to:

- Link sounds to letters.
- Blend and segment the sounds in simple words.
- Write their name & begin to write other words or sentences.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be:

- Continuing or starting to initiate conversations, explaining knowledge & taking account of what others say.
- Beginning to negotiate & resolve any conflicts independently.
- Confident or becoming more confident to speak to others about their own feelings and ideas.

R. E. Come and See

The children will be:

- Exploring the topics of Eucharist – Relating - Gathering and Lent/Easter - Giving.

Physical Development

The children will be:

- Beginning to show increasing control when handling tools, objects and construction materials.
- Beginning to observe the effects of activity on their bodies, noticing that they become warmer and heart beats faster after exercise.
- Beginning to hold a pencil correctly and form recognisable letters.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will be:

- Using a variety of materials to represent events, people and objects, including, Police Officers, fire stations and chicks.
- Exploring our role-play areas, including a medical centre and a vet's surgery.
- Developing storylines alongside their friends as part of a group.
