Mathematics

The children will be beginning to:

- Count reliably with numbers to 20, place them in order & say what is one more or one less than a given number.
- Add & subtract two single digit numbers.
- Use everyday language to talk about money, time & weight.
- Solve problems involving doubling, halving & sharing.

Understanding the World

The children will be beginning to:

- Talk about past & present events in their own lives & lives of family members.
- Make observations of the chicks & talk about similarities, differences & change.
- Talk about features of their own environment.
- Use ICT hardware to interact with age appropriate software.

Literacy/Communication & Language

The children will be beginning to:

- Listen to & comment on what they hear in stories about pirates & jungle animals, & comment about the chicks. Answer how & why questions.
- Develop their own narratives & explanations, connecting their own ideas.
- Show understanding when talking with others about what they have read.
- Take part in story activities with parents and carers.

Phonics

The children will continue or begin to:

- Link sounds to letters.
- Blend and segment the sounds in simple words.
- Read & write simple words and sentences.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be:

- Continuing or starting to play cooperatively, taking turns & showing sensitivity to others feelings.
- Able to work as part of a group, understanding & following rules.
- Confident or becoming more confident to try new activities & speak to others about their own feelings and ideas.
