Mathematics

The children will be:

- Using quantities and objects to add & subtract two single digit numbers.
- Beginning to count reliably with numbers to 20, & say which is one more or one less.
- Beginning to solve problems, doubling, halving and sharing.
- Exploring characteristics of shapes.
- Beginning to use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity and money.

Literacy/Communication & Language

The children will be:

- Extending their vocabulary and using talk to organise their ideas.
- Taking part in story telling activities with parents and carers.
- Beginning to follow instructions and answer 'how' and 'why' questions.
- Enjoy an increasing range of books including, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Bad Tempered Ladybird & Commotion in the Ocean & non-fiction related to minibests.
- Beginning to read, understand & write simple sentences.
- Beginning to write simple sentences.

The children will be:

- Exploring the topics of:

Understanding the World

The children will be:

- Interacting with age appropriate software and beginning to recognise that we use a range of technology.
- Beginning to know about similarities and differences between themselves and others.
- Making observations of animals, plants & our environment, looking at patterns, differences and change including, butterfly life cycle, minibests, birds & exploring the beach.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be:

- Discussing how they show feelings, know that some behaviour is unacceptable.
- Continuing to develop confidence to try new activities & say which activities they enjoy.
- Taking account of others ideas and showing sensitivity to others' feelings.

Phonics

The children will continue to:

- Link sounds to letters.
- Blend and segment the sounds in simple words.
- Write their name and other words and sentences.

Physical Development

The children will be:

- Continuing to move confidently in a range of ways & safely negotiate space.
- Using a pencil effectively to form recognisable letters.
- Showing good control in large & small movements.
- Beginning to know the importance for good health of physical exercise and a healthy diet.
- Beginning to talk about ways to keep healthy and safe.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will be:

- Beginning to represent their ideas by using a variety of media and materials.
- Exploring our role-play areas, including minibests and a beach & representing their own ideas about butterflies, minibests & the beach.
- Developing storylines alongside their friends as part of a group.
- Joining in with drumming sessions & starting to independently experiment with songs, music & dance.
