The children will learn about :

The children will look at examples of older

Literature. They will study the work of C S Lewis and create independent work in the style of this author.

They will plan, draft, review and edit their work.

They will watch clips of classic adaptations, discuss and review aspects of the genre.

They will produce a story in the style of their chosen author.

Widen their experience of older literature.

Read and watch extracts of classic TV and film adaptations

Capture ideas, language and learning to use those in their writing.

Participate in discussions about books that are read to them and those that they read for themselves, building on their own and others ideas.
