Grammar and Punctuation

The children will:

Convert nouns and adjectives in to verbs using suffixes such as 'ate', 'ise', and 'ify'

Continue to use and understand the grammatical terminology from the spring and summer term in their writing, such as: modal verbs, relative pro-

Music

The children will:

Continue to participate in whole school singing sessions and they will use percussion instruments to produce their own music.
