Dear Parents/Carers,

Attendance is Important!

- Pupils with regular attendance make better progress, both socially and academically.
- Pupils with regular attendance find school routines and school work easier to cope with.

Pupils with regular attendance have an easier transfer to secondary school. Children dropping below 90% will be classed as persistent absent and their attendance monitored more closely by the school and the Education Welfare Officer (EWO).

Reasons why an absence MAY be authorised

- Medical appointments (please try and make appointments after school or during the school holidays)
- Pupils personal illness. (If a pupils attendance falls below an acceptable level the absence will not be authorised)
- Family bereavement
- Religious observance
- A leave of absence which has been authorised by the Headteacher

Reason why absence WILL NOT be unauthorised

- Holiday taken without prior approval from the headteacher
- Any other time which has not had prior approval from the headteacher
- Illness of any other family member or caring for someone
- Days off for birthdays
- If your child is over 30 minutes late for registration then this will classed as 'U' Unauthorised absence
- Shopping for new shoes or clothes

Reporting an absence or late

Please inform the school before 8.30am to report your child absent or if they are going to be late. Please note the Community Welfare Officer may contact you for further

Being late to school can have a considerable impact over the whole school year.

The table below shows just how much time can be missed if your child is persistently late to school

5 minutes late everyday = 3 days of school lost over a year

15 minutes late everyday = 10 days of school lost over a year

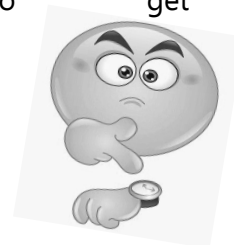
10 minutes late everyday = 6.5 days of school lost over a year

20 minutes late everyday = 13 days of school lost over a year

30 minutes late everyday = 19 days of school lost over a year
