#### **PSED**

#### Physical Development

Use paintbrushes, rollers. Jigsaws. Hold pencil near point & begin to form recognisable letters. Discuss good health & changes to body when exercising. Follow toilet routines, make healthy lunch choices & find own water bottles.

#### **Understanding the World**

Routine of school day. Daily calendar & weather. Our recycling bag. Diversity - what makes us unique. Listen to each other's experience of family life or customs. People who help us. Look at different jobs that people do – challenge gender stereotypes. Magnetic & non-magnetic objects. Changes in outdoor environment – plants beginning to grow, planting. Use Bee Bot – input individual & series of instructions. Use headphones to listen to stories.
